

# Description

Advanced glycation end products (AGEs) are formed from the nonenzymatic reaction of amino groups with reducing sugars.1-3 AGEs have been implicated in diseases, such as diabetes mellitus, non-diabetic nephropathy, macrovascular disease, Alzheimer's disease, cataract, and ageing. 1-3 AGE receptors, such as the receptor for AGE (RAGE), mediate biological responses to AGEs, including endocytic uptake and degradation and induction of cytokines and growth factors. 1-3 GO-BSA was produced by incubating BSA with glyoxal, followed by extensive dialysis.
