Laboratory Procedures

Stability:

17-phenyl trinor Prostaglandin $F_{2\alpha}$ glycinamide (17-phenyl trinor PGF $_{2\alpha}$ glycinamide) is supplied as an oil. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the 17-phenyl trinor PGF $_{2\alpha}$ glycinamide in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. 17-phenyl trinor $PGF_{2\alpha}$ glycinamide is soluble in organic solvents such as ethanol, acetonitrile, DMSO, and dimethyl formamide (DMF). The solubility of 17-phenyl trinor PGF_{2a} glycinamide in ethanol and acetonitrile is approximately 50 and 3 mg/ml, respectively, and approximately 25 mg/ml in DMSO and DMF.

Further dilutions of the stock solution into aqueous buffers or isotonic saline should be made prior to performing biological experiments. Ensure that the residual amount of organic solvent is insignificant, since organic solvents may have physiological effects at low concentrations. Organic solvent-free aqueous solutions of 17-phenyl trinor $PGF_{2\alpha}$ glycinamide can be prepared by directly dissolving the oil in aqueous buffers. The solubility of 17-phenyl trinor $PGF_{2\alpha}$ glycinamide in PBS, pH 7.2, is approximately 0.25 mg/ml. We do not recommend storing the aqueous solution for more than one day.

17-phenyl trinor PGF_{2g} glycinamide is a derivative of 17-phenyl trinor PGF_{2g} ethyl amide (Item No. 16820).
