

Laboratory Procedures

Varenicline-d₄ is intended for use as an internal standard for the quantification of varenicline (Item No. 15030) by GC- or LC-MS. The accuracy of the sample weight in this vial is between 5% over and 2% under the amount shown on the vial. If better precision is required, the deuterated standard should be quantitated against a more precisely weighed unlabeled standard by constructing a standard curve of peak intensity ratios (deuterated versus unlabeled).

Varenicline-d₄ is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the varenicline-d₄ in water. The solubility of varenicline-d₄ in water is approximately 0.0877 mg/ml. We do not recommend storing the aqueous solution for more than one day.

Description

Varenicline is a full agonist of α7 subunit-containing neuronal nicotinic acetylcholine receptors (nAChRs; EC₅₀ = 18 μ M) and a partial agonist of α 4 β 2 subunit-containing nAChRs (EC₅₀ = 2.3 μ M). Formulations containing varenicline have been used as aids in smoking cessation.
