## Laboratory Procedures

Cholesterol  $\beta$ -D-glucoside is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the cholesterol β-D-glucoside in the solvent of choice. Cholesterol β-D-glucoside is soluble in the organic solvent ethanol, which should be purged with an inert gas, at a concentration of approximately 20 mg/ml.

## Description

Cholesterol β-D-glucoside is a derivative of cholesterol that contains β-D-glucose (Item No. 16775). It is formed from cholesterol and glucosylceramide by  $\beta$ -glucosidase 1.<sup>1</sup> It activates heat shock transcription factor 1 (Hsf1) in response to heat shock, which increases the expression of heat shock protein 70 (Hsp70) in TIG-3 human fetal lung fibroblasts when used at a concentration of 10  $\mu$ M.<sup>2</sup> Cholesterol  $\beta$ -D-glucoside (100 mg/kg) prevents ulcer formation following cold-restraint stress and increases Hsf1 activity, as well as Hsp70 expression and protein levels in rat gastric mucosa.<sup>3</sup>
