Trelagliptin-13C-d₃ is intended for use as an internal standard for the quantification of trelagliptin (Item No. 18504) by GC- or LC-MS. The accuracy of the sample weight in this vial is between 5% over and 2% under the amount shown on the vial. If better precision is required, the deuterated standard should be quantitated against a more precisely weighed unlabeled standard by constructing a standard curve of peak intensity ratios (deuterated versus unlabeled).

Trelagliptin- 13 C- d_3 is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the trelagliptin- 13 C- d_3 in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. Trelagliptin- 13 C- 13 C is soluble in the organic solvent DMSO.

Description

Trelagliptin is an inhibitor of dipeptidyl peptidase 4 (DPP-4; $IC_{50} = 4$ nM).¹ It is greater than 10,000-fold selective for DPP-4 over isopeptidases. Trelagliptin (7 mg/kg) inhibits plasma DPP-4 activity and reduces postprandial plasma insulin levels in Zucker fa/fa rats. Formulations containing trelagliptin have been used in the treatment of type 2 diabetes mellitus.
