Laboratory Procedures

Clindamycin palmitate (hydrochloride) is supplied as a crystalline solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the clindamycin palmitate (hydrochloride) in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. Clindamycin palmitate (hydrochloride) is soluble in organic solvents such as ethanol, DMSO, and dimethyl formamide (DMF). The solubility of clindamycin palmitate (hydrochloride) in ethanol is approximately 30 mg/ml and approximately 25 mg/ml in DMSO and DMF.

Description

Clindamycin palmitate is a water-soluble prodrug form of the antibiotic clindamycin (Item No. 15006).¹ It undergoes rapid hydrolysis in vivo to release active clindamycin. Formulations containing clindamycin palmitate have been used in the treatment of various bacterial infections.
