#### Laboratory Procedures

Valganciclovir-d<sub>5</sub> (hydrochloride) is intended for use as an internal standard for the quantification of valganciclovir (Item No. 13875) by GC- or LC-MS. The accuracy of the sample weight in this vial is between 5% over and 2% under the amount shown on the vial. If better precision is required, the deuterated standard should be quantitated against a more precisely weighed unlabeled standard by constructing a standard curve of peak intensity ratios (deuterated versus unlabeled).

Valganciclovir-d<sub>5</sub> (hydrochloride) is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the valganciclovir-d<sub>5</sub> (hydrochloride) in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. Valganciclovir-d<sub>5</sub> (hydrochloride) is soluble in organic solvents such as methanol and DMSO.

#### Description

Valganciclovir is a valyl ester prodrug form of the antiviral nucleoside analog ganciclovir (Item No. 13853). In vivo, valganciclovir (200 mg/kg) increases survival and reduces weight loss in an immunosuppressed hamster model of disseminated adenovirus type 5 (Ad5) infection.<sup>1</sup> Formulations containing valganciclovir have been used in the prevention of post-transplant cytomegalovirus (CMV) infections.
