Laboratory Procedures

Bilaid C1 is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the bilaid C1 in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. Bilaid C1 is soluble in DMSO and methanol.

Description

Bilaid C1 is a tetrapeptide and derivative of bilaid C (Item No. 31246).¹ It binds to the μ -opioid receptor $(K_i = 3.1 \mu M \text{ in HEK293 cell membranes expressing the human receptor}).$
