Laboratory Procedures

5-hydroxy Indomethacin is supplied as a solid. A stock solution may be made by dissolving the 5-hydroxy indomethacin in the solvent of choice, which should be purged with an inert gas. 5-hydroxy Indomethacinis soluble in organic solvents such as ethanol, DMSO, and dimethyl formamide. The solubility of 5-hydroxy indomethacin in these solvents is 3, 15, and 30 mg/ml, respectively.

Description

5-hydroxy Indomethacin is a metabolite of indomethacin (Item No. 70270). It is formed from indomethacin in rabbit hepatic microsomes.
